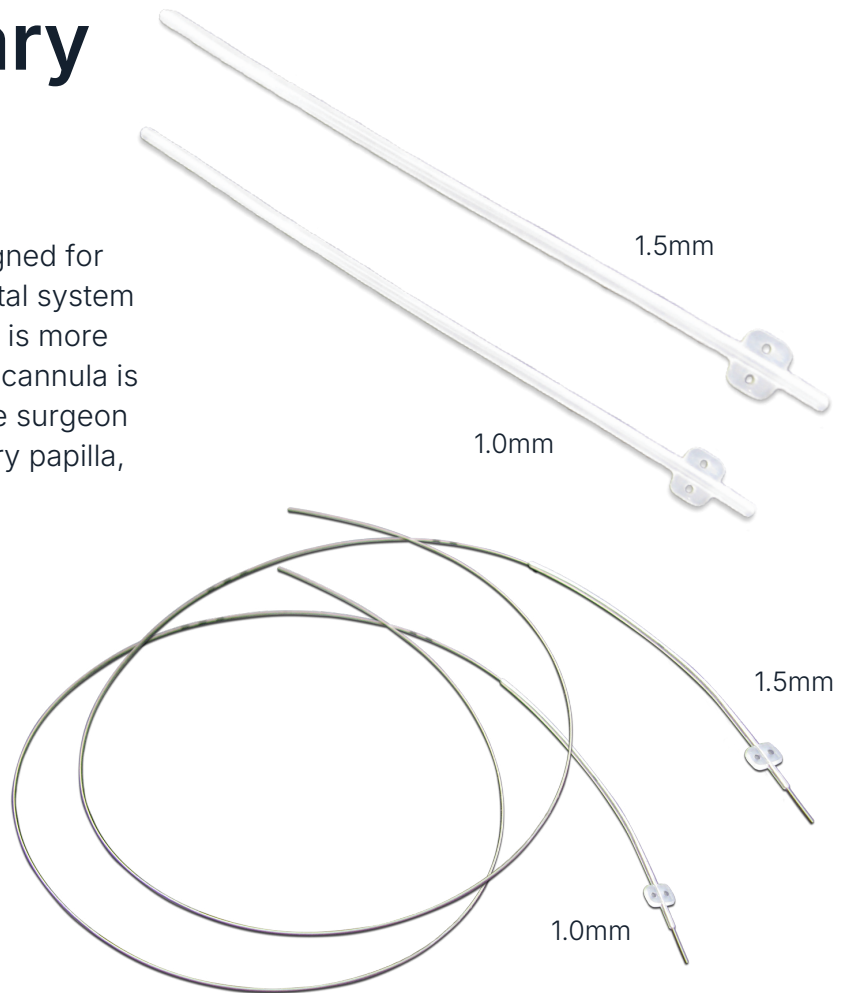
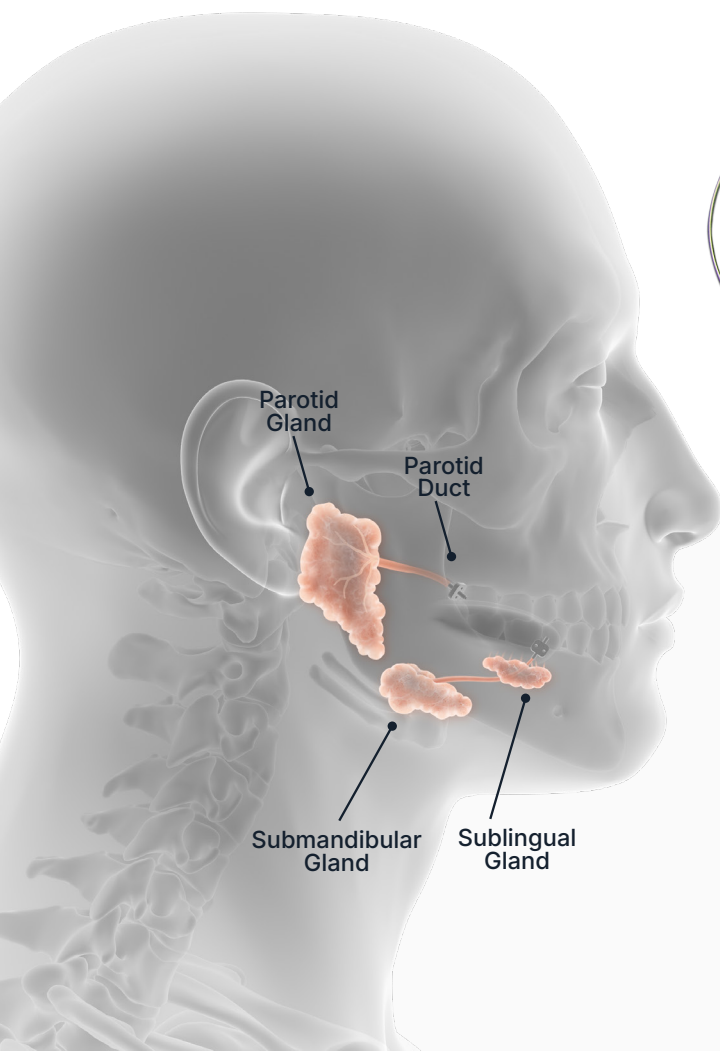


Schaitkin Salivary Duct Cannula

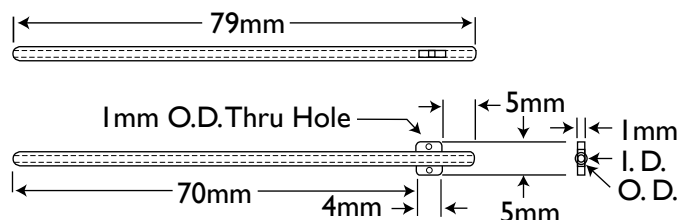
The Schaitkin Salivary Duct Cannula is designed for the short-term intubation of the salivary ductal system and to hold open the ductal tissue. The tube is more than sufficient length for most patients. The cannula is placed at the end of the procedure when the surgeon is concerned about the healing of the salivary papilla, Wharton's duct, or Stenson's duct.



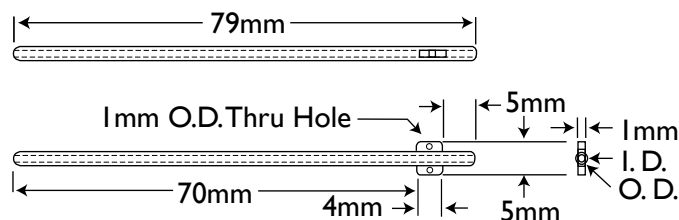
Lumen allows the use of the **Guide Wire** to ease introduction into the papilla, Wharton's duct, or Stenson's duct.

Benefits

- **Short-term stenting** of the salivary papilla, Wharton's duct, or Stenson's duct.
- **Reduces chances of scarring** post endoscopic stone removal.
- Allows **continued saliva flow** through ducts.
- **Convenient suture points** for securing after placement.
- Made of **soft implant-grade silicone** that is well tolerated by patients.

INDICATIONS: Patients who have had more than basic dilation of the papilla may benefit from short-term intubation to allow for drainage of the salivary duct. The cannula can be placed via a sialodochotomy. Patients who have had parotid procedures done externally may have a retrograde insertion.
